We provide clothing (sweats in winter) (shorts/tops in summer) for assault survivors and homeless individuals. This year we also provided 19 safety bars for the survivors' doors. We served approximately 200 individuals this last year.

We receive requests from the individual hospitals in the Columbus for certain types of clothing. Members shop at local stores and then distribute to the umbrella organization that in turn, provides the clothing to the hospitals. We also give clothing to two homeless shelters.
